It is hereby notified that H.S. or equivalent passed Candidate in the year 2024 or earlier up to 2022 may apply Online for 1st Semester Admission to the B.A/ B.Sc./ B.Com Major Courses on the basis of terms and conditions as follows:

1. Application Form to be filled and submitted Online along with fees Rs. Nil for each application for Major Course. **Madhyamik Admit, H.S Mark sheet & Admit Card, School Leaving Certificate and Caste Certificate, PWD Certificate, Sports Certificate, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC-ID) and EWS Certificate** if any to be **uploaded**. Application Form to be downloaded and printed for submission at the time of Admission verification and Confirmation.

It is urgent to mention that if any Mistake (i.e. wrong Marks entry, wrong Subject, wrong Date of Birth etc.) takes place at the time of filling forms, after online submission, then the mistake will be treated as the responsibility of the Applicant alone and the College authority will not take any responsibility for any kind of correction as it is not possible once the form is submitted on Online Portal.

2. Admission Qualifications:

**Eligibility
&
Recognized Boards**

A Candidate may be admitted to the first semester of four-year (Eight Semester) UG- Course for Studies on passing Higher, Secondary (10+2) Examination in general conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination conducted by the State Board/ Council, or The W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling, or The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) recognized by the Distant Education Bureau (DEB) subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:

Candidates

From Other Boards: In case of other Boards/ Councils, a Candidate shall have to pass in five recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in less than five subjects shall not be eligible for admission.

Candidates from

Vocational Stream : However, Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination in Vocational stream conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education & Skill Development (WBSCTVE& SD) or any other equivalent Board/ Council are also eligible for admission provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (Five) recognized subjects, of which one shall be English.

Candidates shall be allowed for admission within 03(Three) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. (For example: candidate passing H.S. Examination in the year 2022 will get last chance of Admission in the academic session 2024-25)

3. Programme of Study:

There shall be following one type Under-Graduate Programme-

- 4- year UG Degree (Honours/ Honours with Research)
- As per the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes, developed by the UGC there will be provisions for awarding UG Certificate, UG Diploma and Basic UG Degree with Major. Separate Rules/ Guidelines will be framed in this regard.
- For 4 year UG Degree (Honours with Research), a student can choose a research stream in the fourth year, subject to fulfillment of the all conditions: laid down by the UGC for implementation of NEP and curriculum credit frame work.

Note: Honours Students not undertaking research will take 3 courses for 12 credits in lieu of research project/ Dissertation.

4. Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

- (i) **4-Year UG Degree (Honours/ Honours with Research):** A Student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/ Councils with at least four Subjects including English as Compulsory subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the UG –Courses of studies on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subjects(s) of the concerned college.
